# 2012 League Descriptions

Metro Gun Club offers a wide-range of shooting activities and a fun environment for outdoor enthusiasts. Our leagues tailor to the individual needs of each person and offer the most flexible times to shoot over any other gun club in the area. *Our banquets are unbeatable too!!! Thousands of dollars in prizes to be won!!!*

All of our leagues also utilize a handicap, so if you don't think you can compete with veteran shooters....don't worry! Our handicap system will allow someone with an average of 10 to compete side by side with someone with an average of 20. This handicap will get put toward the team total and each shooter's individual average will be based on targets actually broke.

We have made a couple changes in regards to last years rules. As in last year, we are allowing individuals to shoot as far in advance as they would like to ensure they get rounds in on time. We encourage anyone with ideas to better our leagues to make the meetings because we rely on your input to better serve everyone involved. Metro Gun Club only follows the rules; it is everyone who attends the meeting that decides what the rules will be.

**Monday Trap:** is a league that uses the first 6 shooters listed each week. Out of those six, we take the best five scores with handicap to use for competition.

**Tri-Combo:** is a league that exposes you to a little bit of everything that we have to offer here; Including Sporting Clays, Duck Tower, Wobble Skeet, Wobble Trap and Skeet. The final decision for what will be shot during the league will be made the night of the meeting. Tri-Combo teams can have up to 10 shooters and each week we will take the best five scores with handicap to use toward competition.

**Ten Person Trap:** is another Monday night trap league and allows you to have 10 people on the team. Each week we will take the best five scores with handicap to use toward competition.

**Youth League:** this trap league targets youths between 11 – 17 years old with firearms safety. This league will start a little later in the season to ensure that there will not be any conflicts with school. The youth league will also allow you to have 10 shooters on the team, using the best five scores with handicap toward competition. **This league will have a \$500 college scholarship prize**, along with the regular banquet prizes and trophies. To be eligible for the \$500 college scholarship participants must shoot all 10 weeks. Winner will be selected randomly by drawing, not by shooting ability.

**Smokeball Skeet:** is a Tuesday night skeet league that features great competition and allows 10 people per team. We take the best five scores with handicap for competition

**Sootball Trap:** is a Tuesday night trap league that also allows you to have 10 shooters on each team. We will take the best 5 scores with handicap to use towards competition.

**Adult / Youth League:** is a Tuesday night, 4 person team league. These 4 person teams will be 2 pairs of Adults / Youth. All 4 scores, with handicap, will be used for competition. **This league will have a \$1,000 college scholarship prize**, along with the regular banquet prizes and trophies. To be eligible for the \$1,000 college scholarship the Parent / Youth pair must shoot all 21 weeks. Winner will be selected randomly by drawing, not by shooting ability.

**Wednesday Claybirds:** is a Trap league that only uses the first five shooters listed. This league is great if you only have five people on your team and want a competitive atmosphere. This league is also nice if you don't have a team and want to be placed on a team. Note: the 1<sup>st</sup> five scores in the league book will count toward competition.

**Dirty Old Men:** is a league that combines trap and skeet. We keep the name for tradition; in fact there are many younger men and women that shoot this league. Dirty Old Men shoots for 20 weeks, alternating trap and skeet every five weeks. This is a great league to change the pace up every once in a while. Dirty Old Men also allows you to have up to 10 people on your team, using only the best 5 scores with handicap each week.

**Sporting Clays:** is a league that utilizes multiple sporting clays fields throughout the season. Generally we use three of the four fields that we have here at Metro. The fields that we will use will be determined at the meeting. This league also allows you to have up to 10 shooters on each team, using only the best five scores with handicap toward competition.

**Thursday G.B.B.:** is a trap league that also uses only the first five shooters listed. You are more than welcome to have an extra or two on the league, but keep in mind that we will only use the first five names listed on the sheet each week.
